

Heritage Glass Museum is a treasure trove. Hidden within its nooks and cranny's are vastly varied segments of knowledge waiting to be discovered. Intricacies of glass history as well as surprising antidotes awaiting the joy of being blindly stumbled upon in the search of knowledge of the past and how it may be surprisingly part of the future.

A cloche (pronounced as Kloshe) was used to protect seedlings from the cold in early spring. The bell shaped glass did have its draw backs as the sun shining through the glass made it possible for the plants to burn. The remarkable thing is that a cloche is still available and used in the garden and in the home.




